

THIS F.A.Q. LIST IS PERIODICALLY UPDATED, ON THE BASIS OF THE MOST FREQUENT QUESTIONS THAT WE RECEIVE.

**1. Who can apply to the Call for foreign students at the Galilean School?**

Non-Italian citizens (both from UE and outside UE), residing **OUTSIDE** Italy. Applicants must hold a Bachelor degree (or be expected to obtain one before July 31st 2018) and not be older than 26 before the application's deadline (**April 4th 2018**). All applicants **must also enroll in a Second Cycle Degree Course** (2-years Master Degree, in Italian **Laurea Magistrale**) at the University of Padova, following the application procedures (available at this [link](#)) and deadlines in the **admission notices** (admission bulletins) of the chosen Course.

Please, pay particular attention to the application **deadlines**, as they are **February 28<sup>th</sup> 2018** for the English-taught Second Cycle Degrees.

Be aware that you won't be examined to join the Galilean School if you are not pre-enrolled and admitted to a Second Cycle Degree at the University of Padova.

**2. Will I have to take part in a selection interview for the Galilean School?**

Only remote interviews via Skype can be a part of the selection process. Please remember to specify your **Skype** nickname in your **CV**; if the selection committee decides to interview you via Skype during the selection process, you will be previously informed by e-mail.

**3. Will I have to choose one of the three Galilean School branches (Class of Moral Sciences, Class of Social Sciences, Class of Natural Sciences)?**

No. The selection committee will suggest you the most suitable Class, according to your interest area, considering your past academic career and the outcome of the possible interview.

**4. Which is the relationship between the enrollment at the University of Padova and the enrollment at the Galilean School?**

- The applicants for the Galilean School must also follow the procedures to apply and eventually enroll at a **Second Cycle Degree Course of the University of Padova**.

- The 4 applicants who will have passed the selection procedure for the Galilean School will be admitted and later enrolled at the Galilean School, **provided that** they have successfully concluded the enrolment procedure at a **Second Cycle degree of the University of Padova**.

The Galilean students will follow the courses and take the exams of the chosen Second Cycle Degree at the University of Padova; at the same time, they will follow the courses and activities and take the internal exams of the Galilean School.

At the end, the successful students will receive both a *Second Cycle Degree Diploma* from the University of Padova and a *Galilean Diploma* from the Galilean School (after a Galilean final discussion).

**5. What if I want to enroll in a course held in Italian, and may not have the possibility to apply before the deadline of the Call?**

The case of foreign students choosing to enroll in a course held in Italian is a bit of an exception to the guidelines indicated in the Call: applications to UniPD courses held in Italian will open in Spring 2018 and close in August, so you may not be able to apply and be admitted to the course before April 4<sup>th</sup> 2018.

In this case, you can just forward your application to the Galilean School and it will be considered valid even if you have not enrolled in the UniPD course yet; just be sure to check the UniPD website for the opening of the applications to the Second Cycle Degree course and apply as soon as possible according to the admission notices.
